Request for Expression of Interest (EOI) for Consultancy Service for Revision of National SLCP Planning Document & Development of a Monitoring and Evaluation Plan

The Department of Environment (DOE) is implementing the project titled "Strengthening Institutional Capacity to Reduce Short-Lived Climate Pollutants (SLCPs)" with the support of UNEP. The project aims to sustainably increase the level of action taken in Bangladesh to reduce Short Lived Climate Pollutants by further promoting the coordination and the scaling-up of activities to reduce SLCPs at the national level.

One of the important areas of operation of this project is to revise the first version of the National SLCP planning document developed during the SNAP (Supporting SLCPs Action Plan) Phase I with the objective of strengthening and securing the national SLCP planning process and achieve endorsement of the report at a high political level.
