About ToT

Training of Trainers (ToT) is a 3-day course on three Rio Conventions viz. United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity (UNCBD), United Nations Convention Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) in a single setting.

Aim of ToT

Aim of the ToT is to build and enhance the capacity of the human resources of the government to mainstream obligations of three Rio Conventions in the national development planning and implementation. Trained government officers are expected to disseminate the training at local level.

Audience of ToT

Target audience of the ToT are the relevant government officials engaged in development planning and implementation. Public training institutes have been influenced to utilize the training.

Training of Trainers (ToT) on Rio Conventions have jointly been organized by Department of Environment, Bangladesh Civil Service Administration Academy and National Academy for Planning and Development. Underscoring the intrinsic values of three Rio Conventions in environmental management, the institutes undertaken this special ToT courses in addition to their regular trainings. The ToT is capacitating the Trainers on Rio Conventions so that the Trainers can transfer the knowledge in their roles and responsibilities from national to project level. The course constitutes of 16.5 hours of class room lectures. Modules and topics cover three Rio Conventions: UNCBD, UNFCCC and UNCCD. A total of 120 participants from 10 ministries, 06 Departments and 10 Public Training Institutions have so far completed the TOT. The participants are mid-level Government officers and 43% was women. The participants were provided with a certificate of completion.
